CITY UTILITY BILLS:

-The City of Goessel bills for water, sewer and trash pick-up

-Water is \$5.00 for 1,500 gallons + \$1.75 per 1,000 additional gallons

-Sewer is based on the average water usage for Jan., Feb., Mar, with a min. charge of \$5.00

-Trash carts are required and provided by Stutzmans Refuse Disposal Inc. at a cost of \$8.35 for a 60 gal. or \$9.05 for a 90 gal. Cost does not include administrative fee and disposal fee. 620-327-4088

-Bills are sent on or about the first of each month and are due by the 10th of that month with a late fee added to the balance on the 11<sup>th</sup>

-Water service is disconnected on the 20th if no payment is received - a \$30 reconnect fee is charged to have service restored

-Payments can be made by mail or by placing in the utility payment box on the front outside wall of the Civic Center

-The city office is open Monday-Fridays – 8 am to 4 pm.

-The Public Works shop is located just to the north of the Fire Station; 214 1/2 East Main; the Public Works Director is not always in the building

-Trash pick-up is on Tues. mornings - have trash at the road by 7:00 am

LEAVES AND BRUSH DISPOSAL:

-The City of Goessel has a no burn ordinance in effect that prohibits any burning other than for cooking purposes

-A tree limb and brush disposal site is located south of West Branch Park off of Summit Street. Only tree limbs, brush, grass clippings, yard and garden waste are allowed. No lumber of any kind.

-This facility is locked; residents need to obtain a key from any city council member, the city clerk, or the public works director; whose names are listed below

-A compost area is also at this same site to accept leaves and grass clippings; this compost is available to city residents when it is ready

DOGS:

-All dogs over the age of six months must be licensed; contact the city clerk for info. on this

-No residence shall have more than two dogs

-All dogs shall be confined or restrained; the Police Chief, Police Officer, and the Public Works Director are authorized to pick up any dog running at large and a pickup fee of \$15.00 will be charged to the owner.
